*"When anxiety was great within me, your consolation brought joy to my heart."* <u>**REFLECTION:**</u> I suppose we all have times when things don't seem to be going right; when we are anxious about various things. As the sage says we have to deal with things we can alter, and things we cannot change - the trick is to be able to discern the difference. We are fortunate to all be gifted with commonsense, and through prayer in action, we can often do something to alleviate our anxiety: that same sense of reason enables us to realise that certain situations cannot be changed. To use a current phrase "It is, what it is".

The spiritual blessing or "consolation" comes when we move from despair, fear, anxiety, worry to a state of acceptance. Other phrases that come to mind when frustration and anxiety pervade are - "banging your head against the wall" or using the biblical phrase, "do not kick against the pricks", referring, I think, to the camel fighting against the goad.

We can spend a lot of time and energy worrying, and the bible has a lot to say about the futility- Jesus words in Matthew 6 and 7 are a comfort and encouragement to get one's priorities right, and moves the reader from worrying about food and clothing, to seeking God's will (his kingdom) and "asking, seeking and knocking".

We have to learn to receive the heartfelt joy that can be ours when we are willing to place all our fears at Jesus' feet, for he "knows our every weakness" (StF 531 v 2) and also to say with the hymnwriter "Father I place into your hands the times that I've been through ...for I know I always can trust you". (StF 519 v. 1) Every blessing, *John.*
