THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK – James 4 verses 13 to 15

"Come now, you who say, "Today or tomorrow, we will go to such and such a town and spend a year there, doing business and making money." Yet you do not even know what tomorrow will bring. What is your life? For you are a mist that appears for a little while and then vanishes. Instead you ought to say, "If the Lord wishes, we will live and do this or that."

COMMENT:

A timely reminder from James that we should not take today or tomorrow for granted.

Some months ago we booked a holiday to Norfolk. Fortunately, nothing prevented us from going and, last week, we had a lovely time. These days, we say "Well, let's book it, and we hope when the time comes, to go." However, being an ex-insurance man, we took out a separate cancellation insurance!

Our lives are truly in God's hands, and as James says we should live by the mantra that, yes, we make plans for the near future and the further future, but it always depends on God's plans for us. As James asks "What is your life?" It indicates to me we should live life to the full, one day at a time: recalling Jesus' promise that when we believe in him we have life abundantly!

It is connected, also I think, to Jesus' words in Matthew 6 about not worrying about tomorrow and provision for clothing, food and drink- trusting God, because he knows we need these things, leaving us free to concentrate on serving God who loves and cares for us.

So we live trusting God, that all will be well, and remembering to say "thank you" when it turns out as we wanted. And if it doesn't, we learn humbly to submit to God's will. Every blessing, *John*.
